We work with local people to promote a diverse, socially just and inclusive community.

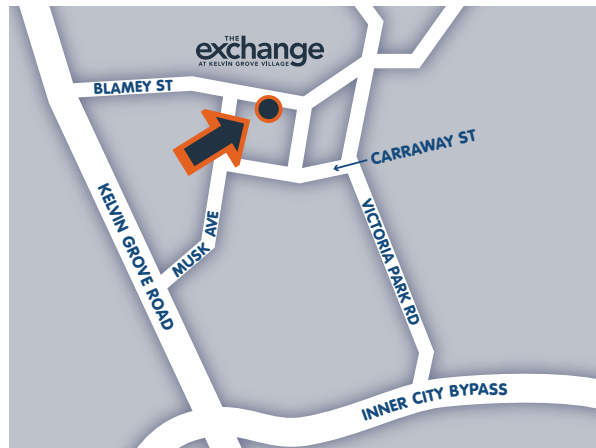

THE exchange

AT KELVIN GROVE VILLAGE

The eXchange is a joint initiative of the Queensland Government, through the Department of Communities and Queensland University of Technology. The partners have provided Community Development funding to establish a community hub in the new Kelvin Grove Urban Village, supporting their vision of creating a place with a distinct identity and a strong sense of community.

What do we offer?

The eXchange hosts a range of services, activities and groups developed around the interests and needs of community members.

A full-time welfare officer is based at the Centre and is available to help people access information and gain referral to services and activities associated with their specific needs. Specialist Community welfare staff are also available by appointment every Thursday morning.

We offer a community education program of learning and leisure focusing on areas such as health and well-being, creating connections, opportunities for learning new life and social skills, recreational pursuits, support with parenting and relationships, and activities for children.

This project has a community development focus that will work with local people to identify issues, needs and opportunities for community capacity building.

An internet café operates each day with sessions for both adults and children.

Opening hours

The eXchange is open from 9am-12pm and 1pm-5pm Monday to Friday

Who is eligible for this service?

The eXchange is open to anyone living in the Kelvin Grove Urban Village or surrounding inner northern suburbs.

Our services include:

- information and referral
- parenting and relationship support
- crisis counselling
- assistance with household and financial management
- no interest loans
- community education
- community development
- opportunity for other groups to hire and access the venue

How much will it cost?

Information, referral and welfare assistance are free services. Courses run by Community are affordable and accessible to all members of the community with concessions and discounts available to eligible people. The venues are made available on a range of rates depending on usage.
